

Senate Bill 857

Sponsored by Senator MONNES ANDERSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes insurers to access utilization data from medical service contracts entered into by Department of Human Services. Updates number of metropolitan statistical areas.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to health care data collection; amending ORS 414.660.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 414.660 is amended to read:

5 414.660. The Department of Human Services shall pursue demonstration projects for medical
6 service contracts in at least the [*four*] **six** standard metropolitan statistical areas in this state and
7 is authorized to seek the necessary federal waivers in order to accomplish such contracts including
8 but not limited to:

9 (1) Limiting the scope of the system to selected geographic areas;

10 (2) Allowing participating health plans to offer benefit enhancements;

11 (3) Limiting the choice of eligible persons to those providers affiliated with a participating
12 health plan;

13 (4) Allowing primary care providers **and insurers** access to data concerning clients' utilization
14 of service from other providers; and

15 (5) Allowing the department the reimbursement flexibility necessary to implement a prospective
16 reimbursement system for hospital care.

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NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
