Senate Bill 858

Sponsored by Senator MONNES ANDERSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Human Services to develop and implement community outreach campaign and media campaign on underage alcohol use. Appropriates moneys for carrying out campaigns. Sunsets January 2, 2016.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to underage alcohol use; and appropriating money.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall develop and implement a commu-

nity outreach campaign to mobilize communities to confront the problem of underage alcohol
 use.

7 SECTION 2. The Department of Human Services shall work with local nonprofit organ-

8 izations to develop and implement a statewide media campaign on underage alcohol use that
9 disseminates information through radio, television, print media and the Internet.

10 <u>SECTION 3.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of the Canaral Fund, the following amounts:

12 the General Fund, the following amounts:

(1) \$6,300,000, which may be expended for developing and implementing the community
 outreach campaign described in section 1 of this 2009 Act.

(2) \$1,000,000, which may be expended for developing and implementing the statewide
 media campaign described in section 2 of this 2009 Act.

17 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Sections 1 and 2 of this 2009 Act are repealed on January 2, 2016.
