

# Senate Bill 858

Sponsored by Senator MONNES ANDERSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Human Services to develop and implement community outreach campaign and media campaign on underage alcohol use. Appropriates moneys for carrying out campaigns. Sunsets January 2, 2016.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to underage alcohol use; and appropriating money.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall develop and implement a commu-**  
5 **nity outreach campaign to mobilize communities to confront the problem of underage alcohol**  
6 **use.**

7 **SECTION 2. The Department of Human Services shall work with local nonprofit organ-**  
8 **izations to develop and implement a statewide media campaign on underage alcohol use that**  
9 **disseminates information through radio, television, print media and the Internet.**

10 **SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**  
11 **ated to the Department of Human Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, out of**  
12 **the General Fund, the following amounts:**

13 (1) **\$6,300,000, which may be expended for developing and implementing the community**  
14 **outreach campaign described in section 1 of this 2009 Act.**

15 (2) **\$1,000,000, which may be expended for developing and implementing the statewide**  
16 **media campaign described in section 2 of this 2009 Act.**

17 **SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2009 Act are repealed on January 2, 2016.**
