

# Senate Bill 86

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Governor Theodore R. Kulongoski for Department of State Police)

## SUMMARY

Modifies procedure for determining security requirements necessary to carry out extradition.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to extradition; amending ORS 133.745.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 133.745 is amended to read:

5 133.745. [*Subject to final determination by*] The Governor[, *the Superintendent of State Police*]  
6 shall determine the security requirements necessary to safely carry out the extradition of a person  
7 from another state including, but not limited to, the number of agents needed to secure the return  
8 of a person under ORS 133.743 to 133.857.
