## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 871

1 Delete lines 4 through 12 of the printed bill and insert:

<sup>2</sup> "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Office of Emergency Management in the Oregon Military Depart-<sup>3</sup> ment may receive gifts, grants, bequests, endowments and donations, in amounts not less <sup>4</sup> than \$250,000, from public and private sources, including federal funds, and may agree to <sup>5</sup> conditions placed on the use of the moneys that are consistent with subsection (3) of this <sup>6</sup> section.

"(2) Moneys received by the Oregon Military Department under this section must be deposited in the Oregon Pre-Disaster Mitigation Fund established in section 4, chapter 18, Oregon Laws 2008, and, notwithstanding section 4, chapter 18, Oregon Laws 2008, are continuously appropriated to the Oregon Military Department for the purposes described in subsection (3) of this section.

12 "(3) Subject to rules applicable to federal grants, the Oregon Military Department shall 13 disburse moneys received under subsection (1) of this section for the purpose of strength-14 ening security in and around facilities of the Jewish Federation of Greater Portland.

"(4) The Oregon Military Department shall adopt rules for the disbursement of moneys
 described in this section.

17 "SECTION 2. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
18 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
19 on July 1, 2009.".
