SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to use one-half of one percent of federal funds department receives for on-the-job training.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation workforce development.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **SECTION 1.** (1) Of the federal funds received by the Department of Transportation, the

department shall expend one-half of one percent for on-the-job training programs related to
highway construction.

- 7 (2) The department shall submit a report to the Legislative Assembly no later than Feb-
- 8 ruary 1 of each odd-numbered year. The report shall contain:

9 (a) An analysis of the results of the department's on-the-job training programs; and

- 10 (b) A description of the amount available to the department from federal funds for 11 training and the amount expended by the department for training.
