

Senate Bill 894

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to use one-half of one percent of federal funds department receives for on-the-job training.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation workforce development.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Of the federal funds received by the Department of Transportation, the**
5 **department shall expend one-half of one percent for on-the-job training programs related to**
6 **highway construction.**

7 **(2) The department shall submit a report to the Legislative Assembly no later than Feb-**
8 **ruary 1 of each odd-numbered year. The report shall contain:**

9 **(a) An analysis of the results of the department's on-the-job training programs; and**

10 **(b) A description of the amount available to the department from federal funds for**
11 **training and the amount expended by the department for training.**
