3	"SECTION 1. (1) Of the federal funds received by the Department of Transportation
4	pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 140(b), the department shall expend one-half of one percent up to an
5	amount of \$1.8 million to increase diversity in the highway construction workforce and pre-
6	pare individuals interested in entering the highway construction workforce by conducting the
7	activities described in subsection (3) of this section.
8	"(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section prohibits the department from expending
9	moneys from sources other than those specified in subsection (1) of this section for the ac-
10	tivities described in subsection (3) of this section.
11	"(3) The department shall use the federal funds specified in subsection (1) of this section
12	to provide:
13	"(a) A state oversight board;
14	"(b) Preapprenticeship programs;
15	"(c) Preemployment counseling;
16	"(d) Orientations on the highway construction industry;
17	"(e) Basic skills improvement classes;
18	"(f) Career counseling;
19	"(g) Remedial training;
20	"(h) Entry requirements for training programs;
21	"(i) Supportive services and assistance with transportation;
22	"(j) Child care and other special needs; and
23	"(k) Job site mentoring and retention services.
24	"(4) The department shall submit a report to the Legislative Assembly no later than
25	December 1 of each even-numbered year. The report shall contain:
26	"(a) An analysis of the results of the department's activities described in subsection (3)
27	of this section; and
28	"(b) A description of:
29	"(A) The amount available to the department from federal funds for the activities de-
30	scribed in subsection (3) of this section and the amount expended by the department for
31	those activities; and
32	"(B) The performance outcomes achieved from each activity including the numbers of
33	persons receiving services, training and employment.
34	"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2009 Act becomes operative October 1, 2009.
35	"SECTION 3. This 2009 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

- 1 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2009 Act takes effect
- 2 on its passage.".

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
