3	"SECTION 1. (1) Of the federal funds received by the Department of Transportation
4	pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 140(b), the department shall expend one-half of one percent up to an
5	amount of \$1.5 million to increase diversity in the highway construction workforce and pre
6	pare individuals interested in entering the highway construction workforce by conducting the
7	activities described in subsection (3) of this section.
8	"(2) Nothing in subsection (1) of this section prohibits the department from expending
9	moneys from sources other than those specified in subsection (1) of this section for the ac
10	tivities described in subsection (3) of this section.
11	"(3) The department shall use the federal funds specified in subsection (1) of this section
12	to provide:
13	"(a) Preapprenticeship programs;
14	"(b) Preemployment counseling;
15	"(c) Orientations on the highway construction industry;
16	"(d) Basic skills improvement classes;
17	"(e) Career counseling;
18	"(f) Remedial training;
19	"(g) Entry requirements for training programs;
20	"(h) Supportive services and assistance with transportation;
21	"(i) Child care and other special needs; and
22	"(j) Job site mentoring and retention services.
23	"(4) The department shall submit a report to the Legislative Assembly no later than
24	December 1 of each even-numbered year. The report shall contain:
25	"(a) An analysis of the results of the department's activities described in subsection (3
26	of this section; and
27	"(b) A description of:
28	"(A) The amount available to the department from federal funds for the activities de
29	scribed in subsection (3) of this section and the amount expended by the department for
30	those activities; and
31	"(B) The performance outcomes achieved from each activity including the numbers o
32	persons receiving services, training and employment.".

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
