## Senate Bill 914

Sponsored by Senator MONNES ANDERSON

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires prepaid managed care health services organization to reimburse community health center or safety net clinic for costs of services provided by center or clinic to enrollee of organization.

1	A BILL	FOR	AN	ACT

- Relating to payment for health care services provided to enrollees of prepaid managed care health services organization.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
  - (a) "Community health center or safety net clinic" means a nonprofit medical clinic or school-based health center that provides primary physical health, vision, dental or mental health services to low-income patients without charge or using a sliding scale based on the income of the patient.
  - (b) "Prepaid managed care health services organization" has the meaning given that term in ORS 414.736.
  - (2) A prepaid managed care health services organization shall reimburse a community health center or safety net clinic for the cost of covered services provided by the center or clinic to an enrollee of the organization.
  - (3) The Department of Human Services shall adopt standards by rule for the reimbursement of community health centers or safety net clinics under this section.
  - <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2009 Act applies to contracts entered into or renewed between the Department of Human Services and a prepaid managed care health services organization on or after the effective date of this 2009 Act.

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
