SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs each public post-secondary institution to report on number of veterans who are attending institution.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to veterans who are attending a post-secondary institution.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

(a) "Public post-secondary institution" means:

(A) A community college;

(B) A state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002; and

(C) The Oregon Health and Science University.

(b) "Veteran" has the meaning given that term in ORS 408.500.

(2) Each public post-secondary institution shall report annually on the number of students attending the institution who are veterans. The report shall specify the number of veterans in each degree or certificate program offered by the institution. The institutions shall report annually to the Department of Veterans' Affairs and the Legislative Assembly. If the Legislative Assembly is not in session, the institutions shall report to the interim committees related to education or veterans' affairs.
