Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:				
SECTION 1. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, the Department of Human Services shall pay the costs of administration and enforcement of duties, functions and powers transferred from the department to the Oregon Health Authority or established in the Oregon Health Authority by section 19 (1), chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2009), amendments to statutes by chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2009), sections 1 to 16 and 1163 to 1179 and 1181 to 1189, chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2009), and other laws, out of moneys appropriated or made available to the department for the duties, functions and powers transferred or established and subject to Acts authorizing or limiting expenditures by the department for the duties, functions and powers transferred or established. SECTION 2. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall pay the costs of administration and enforcement of duties, functions and powers transferred from the department to the Oregon Health Authority by section 19 (2), chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2009), amendments to statutes by chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2009), and other laws, out of moneys appropriated or made available to the department for the duties, functions and powers transferred and subject to Acts authorizing or limiting expenditures by the depart-				
ment for the duties, functions and powers transferred. SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, the Department of Consumer and Business Services shall pay the costs of administration and enforcement of duties, functions				
and powers transferred from the department to the Oregon Health Authority or established in the Oregon Health Authority by section 19 (3), chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2009), amendments to statutes by chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2009), section 17, chapter, Oregon Laws 2009 (Enrolled House Bill 2009), and other laws, out of moneys appropriated or made available to the department for the duties, functions and powers transferred or established and subject to Acts authorizing				
or limiting expenditures by the department for the duties, functions and powers transferred or established. SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, the Office of Private Health Partnerships shall pay the costs of administration and enforcement of duties, functions and powers transferred from the office to the Oregon Health Authority by section 19 (4), chapter
