Requires applicant for renewal of disabled person parking permit to submit certificate from medical professional stating that applicant is person with disability.

1 2 Relating to disabled person parking permits; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 811.604. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. ORS 811.604, as amended by section 30, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2008, is amended 4 to read: 5 811.604. [(1)] Application for issuance or renewal of a disabled person parking permit in the 6 form of an individual placard or decal issued under ORS 811.602 shall include: 7 [(a)] (1) A certificate, signed and dated within six months preceding the date of application, 8 by a licensed physician, a certified nurse practitioner or a licensed physician assistant to the De-9 partment of Transportation that the applicant is a person with a disability or a certificate, signed 10 11 and dated within six months preceding the date of application, by a licensed optometrist that the applicant is a person with a disability because of loss of vision or substantial loss of visual 12 acuity or visual field beyond correction; [and] 13 (2) The state-issued licensing number of the licensed physician, certified nurse practi-14 15 tioner, licensed physician assistant or licensed optometrist who signed the certificate described in subsection (1) of this section; and 16 [(b)] (3) The number of a current, valid driver license, golf cart driver permit, identification card 17 or parking identification card issued to the applicant by the department. 18 [(2) Application for renewal of a disabled person parking permit shall be a signed statement from 19 20 the holder of the permit saying that the person is still qualified to hold the permit.] SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 811.604 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to ap-21 22 plications for issuance or renewal of disabled person parking permits submitted on or after

January 1, 2010.

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
