

# Senate Bill 937

Sponsored by Senator VERGER; Senators HASS, METSGER, MONNES ANDERSON, TELFER, WALKER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires applicant for renewal of disabled person parking permit to submit certificate from medical professional stating that applicant is person with disability.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to disabled person parking permits; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 811.604.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 811.604, as amended by section 30, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2008, is amended  
5 to read:

6 811.604. [(1)] Application for issuance **or renewal** of a disabled person parking permit in the  
7 form of an individual placard or decal issued under ORS 811.602 shall include:

8 [(a)] (1) A certificate by a licensed physician, a certified nurse practitioner or a licensed physi-  
9 cian assistant to the Department of Transportation that the applicant is a person with a disability  
10 or a certificate by a licensed optometrist that the applicant is a person with a disability because  
11 of loss of vision or substantial loss of visual acuity or visual field beyond correction; and

12 [(b)] (2) The number of a current, valid driver license, golf cart driver permit, identification card  
13 or parking identification card issued to the applicant by the department.

14 [(2)] *Application for renewal of a disabled person parking permit shall be a signed statement from*  
15 *the holder of the permit saying that the person is still qualified to hold the permit.*

16 **SECTION 2.** **The amendments to ORS 811.604 by section 1 of this 2009 Act apply to ap-**  
17 **plications for issuance or renewal of disabled person parking permits submitted on or after**  
18 **January 1, 2010.**
