Requires Public Employees' Benefit Board to establish health insurance option for employees of Department of Corrections with access to health care at correctional facility.

The Public Employees' Benefit Board shall establish a health insurance op-6 7 tion for employees of the Department of Corrections who have ready access to health care 8 services within a state correctional facility. The health insurance option shall provide coverage for health services that are not provided at the correctional facility and for services 9 from providers located outside of the correctional facility. 10 11
