2       Whereas William (Bill) Robert Hakim was born on August 31, 1957, and was killed in the line  
3 of duty by a bomb explosion on December 12, 2008; and

4       Whereas William Robert Hakim, born in New York City, spent much of his youth with his family  
5 in Spain and Italy, where he attended elementary school; and

6       Whereas William Robert Hakim settled with his family in Mexico City in 1968, where he began  
7 his secondary education; and

8       Whereas William Robert Hakim led an adventurous childhood, traveling across the Atlantic at  
9 age six on a seven-month cruise, meeting Pablo Picasso and mastering the French, Italian, Spanish  
10 and English languages; and

11       Whereas William Robert Hakim finished high school in Texas, attended St. John's College in  
12 New Mexico, enlisted in the Navy and finished his college education at the University of Texas with  
13 a bachelor of science degree and with a Naval officer rank; and

14       Whereas William Robert Hakim served his country as a naval officer, becoming an explosive  
15 ordinance disposal diver, his proudest accomplishment in the Navy; and

16       Whereas William Robert Hakim continued his world travels while in the Navy, traveling through  
17 the Persian Gulf, Hong Kong, Singapore and the Philippines; and

18       Whereas William Robert Hakim graduated from the Oregon Public Safety Academy in 1997 and  
19 joined the Oregon State Police; and

20       Whereas William Robert Hakim joined the Oregon State Police Arson and Explosives Section  
21 in 1999, where he proudly served until his death; and

22       Whereas William Robert Hakim owned a motorcycle that was his first love until he found his  
23 true love, his wife, Terri; and

24       Whereas William Robert Hakim enjoyed traveling with Terri and their daughter, Page, and son,  
25 Victor, even though it took him away from his 1966 cherry red Ford Mustang (fondly known as the  
26 "money pit"); and

27       Whereas William Robert Hakim loved coaching soccer as a volunteer coach for the Salem Parks  
28 and Recreation Department and enjoyed using his creative talents to build furniture and to master  
29 the barbecue; now, therefore,

30 **Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:**
