Senate Concurrent Resolution 2

Sponsored by Senator COURTNEY, Representative HUNT (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Establishes deadlines for completion of legislative measures and date of adjournment sine die of regular session of Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly.

1	CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
3	(1) The Senate and the House of Representatives shall adhere to the following schedule and
4	deadlines for the regular session of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly:
5	(a) The Senate and the House of Representatives shall convene in regular session on January
6	12, 2009.
7	(b) The Senate and the House of Representatives shall convene their respective floor sessions
8	one day or more each week from, 2009, through, 2009.
9	(c) Members and committees shall submit requests for drafts of measures to the Office of the
10	Legislative Counsel on or before, 2009.
11	(d) Members and committees shall submit drafts of measures for introduction to the Senate and
12	House Desks no later than, 2009.
13	(e) The Senate and House of Representatives may convene daily floor sessions beginning on
14	, 2009.
15	(f) Committee chairpersons shall request fiscal and revenue impact statements for measures in
16	the chamber of origin no later than, 2009. This paragraph does not apply to the Joint
17	Committee on Ways and Means, other joint committees, Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue,
18	House Committee on Revenue, Senate Committee on Rules and House Committee on Elections,
19	Ethics and Rules.
20	(g) Committees shall consider measures in the chamber of origin no later than, 2009.
21	This paragraph does not apply to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means, other joint committees,
22	Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate Committee on
23	Rules and House Committee on Elections, Ethics and Rules.
24	(h) Committee chairpersons shall request fiscal and revenue impact statements no later than
25	, 2009. This paragraph does not apply to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means, other
26	joint committees, Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate
27	Committee on Rules and House Committee on Elections, Ethics and Rules.
28	(i) Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives shall close no later than,
29	2009. This paragraph does not apply to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means, other joint com-
30	mittees, Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue, House Committee on Revenue, Senate Com-
31	mittee on Rules and House Committee on Elections, Ethics and Rules.

- (j) The Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly shall adjourn no later than ______, 2009.
- (2) The rules of the Senate and House of Representatives shall apply to matters not specified in this resolution. The rules of the Senate and House of Representatives may establish timelines for priority measures, for measures approved by the presiding officers or for appropriation and fiscal measures approved by the Joint Committee on Ways and Means that are different from the timelines established in subsection (1) of this resolution.
