Whereas the Legislative Fiscal Office serves as the committee administrative staff for the Joint 11 Committee on Ways and Means and the Emergency Board; and 12

ties as is requested by the other committees and members of the Legislative Assembly; and 14

Whereas the work of the Legislative Fiscal Office is vital to the legislative process; and 15
