WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Designates elected county surveyor office as nonpartisan. Allows elected surveyors to reside outside county of office in counties with populations less than 25,000. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

MEASURE: HB 3672

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Multiple elections and availability of surveyors in counties with smaller populations

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Senate Bill 344 (2009) deleted the office of county surveyor from statutes that list nonpartisan offices. House bill 3672 would restore such designation to the office of county surveyor.
