**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Allows partnership or joint venture to offer or submit bid to perform construction work if named partner or joint venturer is properly licensed and endorsed for work subject to bid. Designates effective date of July 1, 2010.

**MEASURE: HB 3699**

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Current law
- Sunset clause in current law

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Current law allows multiple individuals to enter into a partnership or joint venture to bid on construction projects. A partnership or joint venture may bid on a project if at least one of the named partners or joint venturers has a current license and the appropriate endorsements for the project. This allows a joint venture or partnership to delay the full licensure process until after the bid is awarded. HB 3699 essentially maintains current law, which would otherwise sunset July 1, 2010.
