**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Permits, rather than requires, Oregon Student Assistance Commission to give priority to full-time students if funds are not available to award grants to all students qualified for Oregon Opportunity Grants. Declares emergency; effective upon passage.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Provisions of the measure

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently, ORS 348.250 requires the Oregon Student Assistance Commission to prioritize awarding Oregon Opportunity Grants to full-time students if funds are not available to award grants to all qualified students. House Bill 3702 eliminates this requirement and instead permits the Commission to prioritize full-time students for awards if all qualified students cannot be awarded grants.
