ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- State issue

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Governor of Oregon is the Commander in Chief of the military and naval forces of the State of Oregon, Article V, section 9, Oregon Constitution. The Governor, as Commander in Chief, must appoint an Adjutant General of Oregon National Guard, Article X, section 3, Oregon Constitution. Major General Raymond Rees is currently the Adjutant General.
