EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: During World War II, 9,300 members of the United States Merchant Marine died and 1,554 ships were sunk. However, members of the Merchant Marine never received benefits under the Servicemen's Readjustment Act of 1944.
