EFFECTIVE DATE: On passage.

INTERIM JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS: The budgetary impact of this bill was not reviewed and approved by the Interim Joint Committee on Ways and Means Committee and is not included in the omnibus budget bill to be introduced by the committee.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT MANDATE: This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

ANALYSIS: This bill changes certain provisions of HB 3508 (2009) and expands the list of crimes excluded from the 10% earned time.

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. Under the measure's directives, expanding the list of crimes that would not be eligible for the additional 10% earned time credit, would have a fiscal impact on the Department of Corrections and other agencies. A detailed fiscal impact statement will be issued for the measure when it is considered by the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
