## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3604

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "contracting;" delete the rest of the line and line 3
2	and insert "and declaring an emergency.".
3	Delete lines 5 through 27 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) There is created the Task Force on Regional Contract Preferences,
5	consisting of six members appointed as follows:
6	"(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint three members, two of whom represent
7	construction laborers and one of whom represents construction contractors.
8	"(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint three members, one of
9	whom represents construction laborers and two of whom represent construction contractors.
10	"(2) The task force shall:
11	"(a) Study ways in which this state, through the state's public contracting activities, can
12	encourage construction contractors and businesses to hire regional labor and make use of
13	regionally produced construction materials and other resources;
14	"(b) Devise a methodology for analyzing:
15	"(A) The sources and extent of atmospheric carbon emissions from construction activity,
16	including production and transportation of materials used in construction activity; and
17	"(B) Means for reducing atmospheric carbon emissions;
18	"(c) Study ways to remove barriers that prevent reductions in atmospheric carbon
19	emissions from construction activities; and
20	"(d) Recommend an appropriate size, scope and number of pilot projects necessary to
21	demonstrate the feasibility of the findings and recommendations the task force makes in
22	accordance with this subsection.
23	"(3) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the trans-
24	action of business.
25	"(4) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members
26	of the task force.
27	"(5) The task force shall elect one of the members of the task force to serve as chair-
28	person.
29	"(6) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson
30	or of a majority of the members of the task force.
31	"(7) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.
32	"(8) The task force shall submit a report, and may include recommendations for legis-
33	lation, to the committees of the Legislative Assembly related to business, labor and trans-
34	portation not later than June 30, 2011.
35	"(9) Legislative Committee Services shall provide staff support to the task force.

1 "(10) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation or expenses.

"(11) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the task force in performing the task force's duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force consider necessary to perform the members' duties.

6 "SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2010 Act is repealed on July 1, 2011.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2010 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2010 Act takes effect
on its passage.".

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
