

House Bill 3628

Sponsored by Representative CLEM (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes Superintendent of Public Instruction to enter into contract for purpose of ensuring that Chinese language is available to public school students.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to foreign language instruction; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. For the purpose of ensuring that the instruction of the Mandarin dialect of**
5 **the Chinese language is available to the public school students of this state, the Super-**
6 **intendent of Public Instruction is authorized to enter into a contract with an institution**
7 **that:**

8 (1) **Is public and nonprofit; and**

9 (2) **Specializes in teaching the Mandarin dialect of the Chinese language.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2010 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2010 Act takes effect**
12 **on its passage.**
