## A-Engrossed House Bill 3677

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Permits service station operator to display sign visible from street showing prices for lowest grade of fuel. Requires service station operators who display sign showing prices for lowest grade of fuel to display sign at or near dispensing device showing prices for all grades of fuel. Applies to signs that are new or modified on or after effective date of Act.

## 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 646.930 is amended to read:

- 6 646.930. (1) A person who operates a service station, business or other place for the purpose of
- 7 retailing and delivering gasoline, diesel or other fuel into the tanks of motor vehicles:
- (a) May display on a sign visible from the street the lowest cash prices charged for the sale of
  [all grades] the lowest grades of gasoline, diesel or other fuel.
- (b) If a sign is displayed under paragraph (a) of this subsection, shall display on a sign
  visible at or near any dispensing device all prices charged for the sale of all grades of gasoline, diesel or other fuel offered for sale.
- 13 (2) The following apply to a sign displaying prices under this section:
- (a) The price per unit of measurement and the unit of measurement for a particular kind of fuel
  must be the same on the sign as on any dispensing device used for delivering that kind of fuel into
  the tanks of motor vehicles.
- (b) If a cash price displayed on a sign is available only under some conditions, the sign and thedispensing device must clearly state the conditions.

(c) If a price displayed on a sign is available only in a certain area of the service station or
 business, the area where the price displayed is available must be clearly identified.

(3) A person who displays a cash price that is available only under some conditions may not
 require, as a condition of buying fuel at the displayed price, that the buyer fill the fuel tank of the
 buyer's vehicle.

24 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 646.930 by section 1 of this 2010 Act apply to signs 25 visible from the street that are new or modified on or after the effective date of this 2010 26 Act.
