CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to signs showing motor vehicle fuel prices; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 646.930.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 646.930 is amended to read:

646.930. (1) A person who operates a service station, business or other place for the purpose of retailing and delivering gasoline, diesel or other fuel into the tanks of motor vehicles:

- (a) May display on a sign visible from the street the lowest cash prices charged for the sale of [all grades] the lowest grades of gasoline, diesel or other fuel.
- (b) If a sign is displayed under paragraph (a) of this subsection, shall display on a sign visible at or near any dispensing device all prices charged for the sale of all grades of gasoline, diesel or other fuel offered for sale.
 - (2) The following apply to a sign displaying prices under this section:
- (a) The price per unit of measurement and the unit of measurement for a particular kind of fuel must be the same on the sign as on any dispensing device used for delivering that kind of fuel into the tanks of motor vehicles.
- (b) If a cash price displayed on a sign is available only under some conditions, the sign and the dispensing device must clearly state the conditions.
- (c) If a price displayed on a sign is available only in a certain area of the service station or business, the area where the price displayed is available must be clearly identified.
- (3) A person who displays a cash price that is available only under some conditions may not require, as a condition of buying fuel at the displayed price, that the buyer fill the fuel tank of the buyer's vehicle.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 646.930 by section 1 of this 2010 Act apply to signs visible from the street that are new or modified on or after the effective date of this 2010 Act.
