ORS 346.315 is amended to read: 7 "346.315. (1) The Blind and Visually Impaired Student Fund is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General Fund. Interest earned by the Blind and Visually Impaired 8 9 Student Fund shall be credited to the Blind and Visually Impaired Student Fund. 10 "(2) Moneys in the Blind and Visually Impaired Student Fund are continuously appropriated to 11 the Department of Education for the purposes of: 12 "(a) Assisting students who are blind or visually impaired in receiving appropriate resources and 13 services, including educational services, in the communities where the students reside or in other 14 settings identified in individualized education programs for students described in section 3 15(1), chapter 562, Oregon Laws 2009; 16 (b) Supplementing funds available to regional programs authorized under ORS 343.236 (1)(a)(A) 17 and (C) to ensure access to the expanded core curriculum for students who are blind or visually 18 impaired: 19 "(c) Coordinating professional development of persons who provide educational services to stu-20 dents who are blind or visually impaired; 21"(d) Providing technical assistance for the purpose of providing educational services to students 22who are blind or visually impaired; and 23 "(e) Coordinating activities for the benefit of students who are blind or visually impaired. 24 "(3) When determining the manner in which to spend the moneys in the Blind and Visually Im-25paired Student Fund, the Department of Education shall: 26"(a) Give priority to services or resources used by students described in section 3 (1), chapter 27562, Oregon Laws 2009; and 28"(b) Ensure that the moneys are used in addition to any other available moneys and do not 29supplant moneys available from any other source. "(4) Notwithstanding subsection (3)(b) of this section, a school district is not required to 30 31 seek moneys from the High Cost Disabilities Account established by ORS 327.348 prior to 32seeking moneys from the Blind and Visually Impaired Student Fund for costs associated with 33 providing services to a student if: 34 "(a) The student is a student described in section 3 (1), chapter 562, Oregon Laws 2009; 35"(b) The purpose of the moneys is to provide appropriate resources and services, includ-

- 1 ing educational services, in a setting identified in the individualized education program for
- 2 the student; and
- "(c) The total cost of the resources and services includes both medical and educational
 costs and exceeds \$200,000 per fiscal year.".
