

# House Bill 3699

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON CONSUMER PROTECTION AND GOVERNMENT ACCOUNTABILITY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows partnership or joint venture to offer or submit bid to perform construction work if named partner or joint venturer is properly licensed and endorsed for work.

Takes effect July 1, 2010.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to construction contractors; amending ORS 701.021; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 701.021 is amended to read:

5 701.021. (1) Except as provided in ORS 701.010, a person or joint venture that undertakes, offers  
6 to undertake or submits a bid to do work as a contractor must have a current license issued by the  
7 Construction Contractors Board and possess an appropriate endorsement as provided in this section.

8 **For purposes of offering to undertake or submitting a bid to do work, a partnership or joint**  
9 **venture is licensed and endorsed if any partner or joint venturer whose name appears in the**  
10 **business name of the partnership or joint venture has a current license issued by the board**  
11 **and possesses an appropriate endorsement.**

12 (2) A person or joint venture that undertakes, offers to undertake or submits a bid to do work  
13 as a contractor in preparation for or in connection with a residential structure must have one of  
14 the following endorsements:

15 (a) Residential general contractor.

16 (b) Residential specialty contractor.

17 (c) Residential limited contractor.

18 (d) Residential developer.

19 (3) A person or joint venture that undertakes, offers to undertake or submits a bid to do work  
20 as a contractor in preparation for or in connection with a small commercial structure must have  
21 one of the following endorsements:

22 (a) Residential general contractor.

23 (b) Residential specialty contractor.

24 (c) Residential limited contractor.

25 (d) Residential developer.

26 (e) Commercial general contractor level 1.

27 (f) Commercial specialty contractor level 1.

28 (g) Commercial general contractor level 2.

29 (h) Commercial specialty contractor level 2.

30 (i) Commercial developer.

31 (4) A person or joint venture that undertakes, offers to undertake or submits a bid to do work

- 3 (a) Commercial general contractor level 1.
- 4 (b) Commercial specialty contractor level 1.
- 5 (c) Commercial general contractor level 2.
- 6 (d) Commercial specialty contractor level 2.
- 7 (e) Commercial developer.

8 **SECTION 2. This 2010 Act takes effect July 1, 2010.**
