

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3704

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after “cooperatives” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

2 After line 26, insert:

3 “(5)(a) For purposes of this subsection, beverage container return rate is calculated by dividing
4 the number of beverage containers returned in Oregon during the calendar year by the number of
5 beverage containers sold for a refund value during the calendar year.

6 “(b) By July 1 of each calendar year, a distributor cooperative shall provide the Oregon Liquor
7 Control Commission with a report that lists, in aggregate form for all distributors and importers that
8 participate in the distributor cooperative, the previous calendar year’s beverage container return
9 rate, calculated separately for aluminum, glass and plastic containers.

10 “(c) By July 1 of each calendar year, a distributor or importer that does not participate in a
11 distributor cooperative shall provide the commission with a report that lists the distributor’s or the
12 importer’s beverage container return rate for the previous calendar year, calculated separately for
13 aluminum, glass and plastic containers.

14 “**SECTION 3. The first reports to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission under section**
15 **2 (5) of this 2010 Act must be filed no later than July 1, 2010, for calendar year 2009.**

16 “**SECTION 4. This 2010 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2010 Act takes effect**
18 **on its passage.”**
