## House Bill 3707

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Prescribes ballot title, estimate of financial impact and explanatory statement for House Joint Resolution  $101\ (2010)$ .

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to elections; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Except as otherwise provided in this 2010 Act, ORS chapters 250, 251 and 254
5	apply to an election held on House Joint Resolution 101 (2010).
6	SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 250.035, 250.067, 250.075 (2) and 250.085 (3), the ballot
7	title for House Joint Resolution 101 (2010) shall be:

15	(2) ORS 250.085 does not apply to the ballot title prepared under this section. The ballot
16	title prepared under this section shall be the ballot title printed in the voters' pamphlet and
17	printed on, or included with, the ballot.
18	SECTION 3. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 250.125, 250.127 and 250.131, the estimate of finan-
19	cial impact for House Joint Resolution 101 (2010) to be printed in the voters' pamphlet and
20	printed on, or included with, the ballot shall be:
