

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5101

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

February 23

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “appropriating money; limiting expenditures;”.

2 Delete lines 5 through 18 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative**
4 **Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Business Development**
5 **Department established by section 3 (1), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium**
6 **beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$336,778.**

7 **“SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-**
8 **tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Business Develop-**
9 **ment Department established by section 3 (5), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the**
10 **biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$2,079,041.**

11 **“(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established**
12 **by section 18 (2)(b)(A), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$2,079,041.**

13 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative**
14 **Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Education es-**
15 **tablished by section 4, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1,**
16 **2009, is decreased by \$29,980,328.**

17 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative**
18 **Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Problem Gambling Treatment**
19 **Fund established by section 6, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning**
20 **July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$653,972.**

21 **“SECTION 5. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-**
22 **tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Housing and Community**
23 **Services Department established by section 9a, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the**
24 **biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$161,246.**

25 **“(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established**
26 **by section 18 (2)(b)(C), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$161,246.**

27 **“SECTION 6. (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-**
28 **tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Ad-**
29 **ministrative Services established by section 10, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the**
30 **biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$1,555.**

31 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services**
32 **Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Administrative**
33 **Services established by section 11, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning**
34 **July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$213,545.**

35 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services**

1 Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Administrative
2 Services established by section 37, chapter 885, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning
3 July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$215,100.

4 “**SECTION 7.** (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administra-
5 tive Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Community
6 Colleges and Workforce Development established by section 13a, chapter 905, Oregon Laws
7 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$73,698.

8 “(2) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative Services
9 Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Department of Community Colleges and
10 Workforce Development established by section 13b, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the
11 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$376,500.

12 “(3) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
13 by section 18 (2)(b)(H), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$450,198.

14 “**SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
15 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the office of the Governor estab-
16 lished by section 14, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009,
17 is decreased by \$72,315.

18 “**SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Administrative
19 Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of Admin-
20 istrative Services established by section 16, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium
21 beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$3,270,834.

22 “**SECTION 10.** (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Adminis-
23 trative Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the State Forestry Depart-
24 ment established by section 17a, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium beginning
25 July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$133,465.

26 “(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
27 by section 18 (2)(b)(J), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$133,465.

28 “**SECTION 11.** (1) Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Adminis-
29 trative Services Economic Development Fund, the allocation to the Oregon Department of
30 Administrative Services established by section 17c, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, for the
31 biennium beginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$156,951.

32 “(2) Notwithstanding section 18, chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, the amount established
33 by section 18 (2)(b)(D), chapter 905, Oregon Laws 2009, is decreased by \$156,951.

34 “**SECTION 12.** Notwithstanding any other law allocating moneys from the Criminal Fine
35 and Assessment Account, the allocation to the Department of Public Safety Standards and
36 Training established by section 3 (1), chapter 861, Oregon Laws 2009, for the biennium be-
37 ginning July 1, 2009, is decreased by \$1,800,000.

38 “**SECTION 13.** (1) Notwithstanding ORS 461.558 and except as provided in subsection (2)
39 of this section, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2009, the amount of the lottery ending
40 balance transferred as provided in ORS 461.558 to the school capital matching subaccount
41 created within the Education Stability Fund by section 4 (8), Article XV of the Oregon Con-
42 stitution, shall be an amount equal to the greater of:

43 “(a) The difference between the lottery ending balance and the total amount of the de-
44 creases in allocations made by sections 1 to 11 of this 2010 Act; or

45 “(b) Zero.

1 “(2) For purposes of subsection (1) of this section, the decreases in allocations made by
2 sections 1 to 11 of this 2010 Act do not include the decrease made by section 6 (3) of this 2010
3 Act.

4 “SECTION 14. This 2010 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
5 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2010 Act takes effect
6 on its passage.”.
