Senate Bill 1053

SUMMARY

Requires public utilities and consumer-owned utilities to disclose information to customers on costs of compliance with environmental regulations, rules and laws.

- 2 Relating to disclosure of environmental costs to utility customers.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - <u>SECTION 1.</u> Sections 2 and 3 of this 2010 Act are added to and made a part of ORS chapter 757.
 - SECTION 2. (1) In any utility bill provided to customers, a public utility shall disclose the amount and percentage of the total bill that is attributable to the public utility's costs of complying with federal and state environmental regulations, rules and laws.
 - (2) A public utility shall provide the information required to be disclosed under this section in a form that is easily understood.
 - (3) The Public Utility Commission shall adopt rules relating to:
 - (a) The federal and state environmental regulations, rules and laws to be cited by a public utility in determining amounts and percentages required to be disclosed under this section.
 - (b) The form in which information required to be disclosed under this section must be presented in utility bills provided to customers.
 - SECTION 3. (1) In any utility bill provided to customers, a consumer-owned utility as defined in ORS 757.270 shall disclose the amount and percentage of the total bill that is attributable to the consumer-owned utility's costs of complying with federal and state environmental regulations, rules and laws.
 - (2) A consumer-owned utility shall provide the information required to be disclosed under this section in a form that is easily understood.
 - (3) A consumer-owned utility shall provide information required to be disclosed under this section in a form substantially similar to that prescribed by the Public Utility Commission by rule pursuant to section 2 of this 2010 Act.

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
