

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1060

By COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “creating new provisions; amending ORS 105.672;”.
- 2 Delete lines 4 through 29 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
- 3 **“SECTION 1. (1) There is created the Task Force on Waterways, consisting of 17 mem-**
- 4 **bers appointed as follows:**
- 5 **“(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint:**
- 6 **“(A) Two members from among members of the Senate.**
- 7 **“(B) Six members as follows:**
- 8 **“(i) One member of the general public;**
- 9 **“(ii) One member representing the interests of ports;**
- 10 **“(iii) Two members representing the interests of conservation groups and recreational**
- 11 **users of waterways; and**
- 12 **“(iv) Two members representing the interests of business, agriculture, timber and prop-**
- 13 **erty owners.**
- 14 **“(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint:**
- 15 **“(A) Two members from among members of the House of Representatives.**
- 16 **“(B) Six members as follows:**
- 17 **“(i) One member of the general public;**
- 18 **“(ii) One member representing the interests of local government, as that term is defined**
- 19 **in ORS 174.116;**
- 20 **“(iii) Two members representing the interests of conservation groups and recreational**
- 21 **users; and**
- 22 **“(iv) Two members representing the interests of business, agriculture, timber and prop-**
- 23 **erty owners.**
- 24 **“(c) The State Land Board shall designate one of its members to serve on the task force,**
- 25 **who shall serve as chairperson.**
- 26 **“(2) The task force shall study the use by the public of waterways, reviewing relevant**
- 27 **considerations including but not limited to the public use doctrine, judicial opinions and the**
- 28 **interests of landowners who own property adjacent to waterways.**
- 29 **“(3) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the trans-**
- 30 **action of business.**
- 31 **“(4) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members**
- 32 **of the task force.**
- 33 **“(5) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as vice chairperson who shall**
- 34 **carry out the duties of the chairperson in the absence of the chairperson.**
- 35 **“(6) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**

1 **ment to become immediately effective.**

2 **“(7) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
3 **or of a majority of the members of the task force.**

4 **“(8) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

5 **“(9) The task force shall submit a report summarizing the results of the study conducted**
6 **under subsection (2) of this section, and shall include recommendations for legislation, in-**
7 **cluding proposed language, to the interim legislative committees on environment and natural**
8 **resources on or before December 1, 2010.**

9 **“(10) The Department of State Lands shall provide staff support to the task force.**

10 **“(11) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation or reimbursement for**
11 **expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

12 **“(12) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
13 **the task force in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating**
14 **to confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the task force**
15 **consider necessary to perform their duties.**

16 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2010 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the**
17 **next regular biennial legislative session.**

18 **“SECTION 3. This 2010 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
19 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2010 Act takes effect**
20 **on its passage.”**

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
