SUMMARY

Allows Adjutant General to continue term if federal recognition of Adjutant General is withdrawn because of age.
Sunsets January 2, 2014.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to the Adjutant General; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 396.150, if federal recognition of the Adjutant General
5	is withdrawn because of the Adjutant General's age, the term of the Adjutant General con-
6	tinues until its prescribed expiration date.
7	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2010 Act is repealed on January 2, 2014.
8	SECTION 3. This 2010 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2010 Act takes effect
10	on its passage.
