

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5563

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, delete “and 20” and insert “, 20 and 37”.

2 On page 4, delete line 17 and insert:

3 “(8) Reserves - 11,390,970 - - 5,771,710”.

4 On page 10, after line 15, insert:

5 **“SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
6 **\$900,000 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for**  
7 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**  
8 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of**  
9 **Corrections for replacing irrigation wells on the property referred to as the Mill Creek**  
10 **property in Salem.**

11 **“SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
12 **expenditures established by section 1 (5)(a), chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2007, for a six-year**  
13 **period beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for the payment of expenses from fees,**  
14 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and**  
15 **federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Corrections for deferred mainte-**  
16 **nance and assessment project management staff is increased by \$1,425,912.**

17 **“SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
18 **expenditures established by section 1 (1)(b), chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2007, for a six-year**  
19 **period beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for the payment of expenses from fees,**  
20 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and**  
21 **federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Transportation for the acquisition**  
22 **of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equip-**  
23 **ping of the Transportation Building is increased by \$64,733,792.**

24 **“SECTION 13. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
25 **\$12,100,000 is established for the six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit**  
26 **for the expenditure of federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department**  
27 **for the acquisition of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing,**  
28 **furnishing and equipping of the Polk County Readiness Center.**

29 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures**  
30 **established by section 7, chapter 26, Oregon Laws 2009, for the six-year period beginning July**  
31 **1, 2007, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues,**  
32 **including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or**  
33 **received by the Oregon Military Department for the acquisition of land in Dallas, Oregon,**  
34 **and for the construction of a new Polk County Readiness Center to replace the existing**  
35 **Dallas Armory is increased by \$5,580,960.**

1       “(3) Any reference in section 7, chapter 26, Oregon Laws 2009, to the Dallas Readiness  
2 Center is considered a reference to the Polk County Readiness Center.

3       “**SECTION 14.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
4 expenditures established by section 1 (9)(c), chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2007, for a six-year  
5 period beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for the payment of expenses from fees,  
6 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and  
7 federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department for the acquisition  
8 of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equip-  
9 ping of the Woodburn Armory Addition/Alteration is decreased by \$3,145,057.

10       “**SECTION 15.** (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
11 expenditures established by section 1 (7)(b), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, for a six-year  
12 period beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for the payment of expenses from fees,  
13 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and  
14 federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department for the acquisition  
15 of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equip-  
16 ping of the Hood River Armory is decreased by \$1,358,762.

17       “(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on expenditures  
18 established by section 1 (7)(c), chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, for a six-year period beginning  
19 July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for the payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other  
20 revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds,  
21 collected or received by the Oregon Military Department for the acquisition of land and the  
22 acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping of the  
23 Milton-Freewater Armory is decreased by \$961,407.

24       “**SECTION 16.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on  
25 expenditures established by section 2 (1)(a), chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2007, for a six-year  
26 period beginning July 1, 2007, as the maximum limit for the expenditure of federal funds  
27 collected or received by the Oregon Military Department for the acquisition of land and the  
28 acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing, furnishing and equipping of the  
29 Ontario Readiness Center is increased by \$265,000.

30       “**SECTION 17.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
31 \$619,000 is established for the six-year period beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit  
32 for the expenditure of federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Military Department  
33 for the acquisition of land and the acquisition, planning, constructing, altering, repairing,  
34 furnishing and equipping of a high-voltage electrical loop project at Camp Rilea.

35       “**SECTION 18.** The expiration date of the project approvals and expenditure limitations  
36 authorized by the Legislative Assembly for the Oregon Military Department for the Lane  
37 County Armed Forces Reserve Center Complex is extended to June 30, 2011.

38       “**SECTION 19.** Section 37, chapter 904, Oregon Laws 2009, is amended to read:

39       “**Sec. 37.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are es-  
40 tablished for [*the biennium*] a **six-year period** beginning July 1, 2009, as the maximum limit for  
41 payment of expenses under this section from bond proceeds collected or received by the Department  
42 of Community Colleges and Workforce Development for community college districts for capital con-  
43 struction, deferred maintenance, capital renewal, code compliance and safety projects:
