## Senate Bill 5564

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Reduces amount authorized for issuance of Article XI-G bonds by Oregon University System for biennium beginning July 1, 2009.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.
