Senate Concurrent Resolution 23

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Recognizes and honors achievements of football programs of University of Oregon and Oregon State University during 2009 season.

2	Whereas the 2009 football programs of the University of Oregon and Oregon State University
3	experienced outstanding seasons in the Pac-10 Conference; and
4	Whereas the efforts of both programs propelled the State of Oregon into the national limelight

6	Whereas both Oregon and Oregon State were recognized in the nation's top-25 rankings during
7	much of the season; and
8	Whereas on December 3, 2009, Oregon and Oregon State met for the 113th time in the annua
9	Civil War game; and
10	Whereas for the first time in Civil War history the two teams played for the right to represent
11	the Pac-10 Conference at the Rose Bowl Game in Pasadena, California; and
12	Whereas both teams played the game with pride, determination and honor; and
13	Whereas Oregon won the game 37-33 in one of the most outstanding contests in the 113-year
14	history of the rivalry; and
15	Whereas Oregon represented the State of Oregon in the Rose Bowl and Oregon State repres
16	ented the State of Oregon in the Las Vegas Bowl while finishing first and second in the Pac-10 race

18	Whereas Oregon Coach Chip Kelly was named Pac-10 Coach of the Year and Oregon State
19	coached by Mike Riley, had seven players named to the All-Pac-10 first team, which is more than
20	any other school; and
21	Whereas their efforts, conduct and exemplary play brought pride to all Oregonians; now, there

23	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
24	That we, the members of the Seventy-fifth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon, in spe
25	cial legislative session assembled, on behalf of all Oregonians, recognize, honor and celebrate the
26	achievements of the football programs of the University of Oregon and Oregon State University; and
