

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE NO. 2 AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 41

February 25

Amended Summary

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to require annual sessions of Legislative Assembly. Provides that session beginning in odd-numbered year may not exceed [165] **160** calendar days, and session beginning in even-numbered year may not exceed [45] **35** calendar days. Permits organizational session that is not subject to time limits. Allows extensions by affirmative vote of two-thirds of members of each house.

Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election held throughout this state.

Your Conference Committee to whom was referred B-engrossed Senate Joint Resolution 41, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that the Senate concur in the House amendments dated February 23 and that the resolution be amended as follows and readopted.
