APPOINTMENT/CONFIRMATION AUTHORITY: **ORS 342.930**

TERM: Aranda, Betts, Gardner: Four-year term: Dec. 13, 2012 – Dec. 12, 2016

ECONOMIC INTEREST FILING (ORS 244.050): Not required.

STATUTORY QUALIFICATIONS: **ORS 660.110**

Affirmative action policy: See ORS 182.100. Diversity criteria: See ORS 236.115.

- Nine members, including the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries (AVAKIAN).
- Eight members appointed by the Governor for four-year terms:
 - Four members from apprenticeable building and construction crafts or trades that have programs approved and registered with the council, including two members representing employers and two members representing employees (POLLOCK, ROZELL, WILSON, Vacancy)
 - Two members from other apprenticeable occupations that have programs approved and registered with the council, including one member representing employers and one member representing employees (ARANDA, FERGUSON)
 - Three members representing the public (BETTS, DAVIS, GARDNER)
- To qualify for the position, individuals shall provide the Governor with documentation showing that they meet at least one of the following requirements:
 - Active participation on an apprenticeship governing body for a minimum of four years; or
 - A minimum of four years of experience in workforce development or investment activities, vocational training or education, apprenticeship program administration or a related discipline.

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY: **ORS 660.110 & 660.120**

- Rulemaking; enforcing the provisions of ORS chapter 660
- With assistance of director and director's staff, conduct investigations, issue subpoenas, obtain evidence, administer oaths and take testimony in matters related to its duties
- Establish policy of the apprenticeship program to encourage promotion, expansion and improvement of programs
- Cooperate with interested state and federal agencies and other training providers, such as community colleges, educational service districts, and recognized industry programs
- Approve and register program standards submitted by appropriate local joint committees
- Establish committees and approve nominations of members and alternates to local and state joint committees to ensure a balanced representation of employer and employee groups
- De-register standards, terminate programs and remove members of any committee for inactivity or inadequate activity, failure to abide by the provisions of Chapter 660

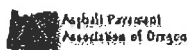
