WHAT THE BILL DOES: Requires a school district to pay, for purposes of the distribution of the State School Fund, to a public charter school sponsored by the board of the school district or by the State Board of Education that is within the boundaries of the school district, an amount per weighted average daily membership (ADMw) of the public charter school that is at least equal to 95 percent of the amount of the school district's General Purpose Grant per ADMw, and at least 95 percent of state or federal moneys if they are received by the school district for its public charter schools.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS:

BACKGROUND: Currently, for purposes of the distribution of the State School Fund, a school district is directed to pay to a public charter school sponsored by the board of the school district or by the State Board of Education that is within the boundaries of the school district, an amount per weighted average daily membership (ADMw) of the public charter school that is at least equal to (1) 80 percent of the amount of the school district's General Purpose Grant per ADMw for students in kindergarten and grades 1-8, and (2) 95 percent for students in grades 9-12.
