Measure Description:

Increases maximum fee for recording certain county documents.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Counties, State Agencies, and State Political Subdivisions

Summary of Expenditure Impact: See Analysis

Local Government Mandate:

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

Analysis:

The measure allows county clerks to increase, from \$10 to \$20, the maximum fee charged for recording certain documents. These documents include deeds, liens, and other instruments related to title or interest in real property.

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House General Government and Consumer Protection Committee to the House Revenue Committee. The bill's fiscal impact to counties, state agencies, and other political subdivisions is indeterminate. A more complete fiscal analysis will be prepared as the bill is considered in the House Revenue Committee.
