**Measure Description:**

Allows person to claim special assessment for farmland used in farming less than five years if person makes sufficient farming-related investments in property.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Land Conservation and Development, Department of Agriculture, Department of Revenue

**Analysis:**
