Measure Description: Allows a justice court to assign certain collection activities to the Department of Revenue if it submits an annual report to the Legislative Fiscal Office regarding the court's liquidated and delinquent accounts.

Revenue Impact: None

Impact Explanation: Due to the permissive language of the bill, there is no revenue impact included in this statement. However, because the bill would allow justice courts access to the collections services provided by the Department of Revenue, there could be a gain to Other Funds as well as the General Fund. Over the past two years, the Department of Revenue has collected roughly \$100,000 for the justice courts through the refund offset program. This amount would likely increase if full collection services were provided. Total collections, to Other Funds and the General Fund, would increase depending on the level of activity and resources devoted to the collections process.
