**Measure Description:**

Requires interest on moneys in Oregon Rainy Day Fund to accrue to and become part of the general fund when certain conditions are met. Removes requirements that the interest earnings on several other funds to be transferred or credited to the General Fund. Redirects interest earnings and other investment income derived from certain amounts in the Oregon University System Fund to the Oregon Rainy Day Fund instead of the General Fund

**Local Government Mandate:**

This bill does not affect local governments' service levels or shared revenues sufficient to trigger Section 15, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution.

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Finance and Revenue to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means. The bill makes substantive changes to state financing statutes that may impact budgeting processes.
