Measure Description:

Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to enter compact with other states to allocate among states premium taxes paid to insured's home state.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS), Oregon State Police (OSP)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
