#### Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

##### Public Hearing

HB 3125

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits certain persons from applying for or possessing licenses, tags and permits to take or hunt wildlife.

HB 3290

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies application of farm income standard adopted by Land Conservation and Development Commission for establishing primary and accessory dwellings customarily provided in conjunction with farm use in areas zoned for exclusive farm use.

HB 3465

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Authorizes owner of Silvies Valley Ranch Development Area to develop 500-acre guest ranch with up to 575 units of overnight accommodations and commercial uses.

##### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2875

Specifies that public lands used for wildlife management purposes must be accessible for hunting.
