- SB 151  
Expands and clarifies authority of Housing and Community Services Department regarding use of moneys in Housing Development and Guarantee Account.
- SB 221  
Makes permanent provisions allowing health care representative to consent to hospitalization of principal for treatment of behavior caused by dementia.
- SB 141  
Modifies provisions relating to State Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology and licensure of speech-language pathologists and audiologists.
- SB 104  
In Family Health Insurance Assistance Program, eliminates asset criteria and authorizes Office of Private Health Partnerships to offer dental only plans, adopt definition of family by rule and adopt rules for recovery of overpayments of subsidies.
