Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 140
Allows Occupational Therapy Licensing Board to deny, suspend, revoke or refuse to renew license or impose probationary conditions if licensee or applicant violates statutes administered by board.
- SB 555
Adds new definitions and requirements for health insurance coverage of autism spectrum disorders.
- SB 207
Requires Oregon Patient Safety Commission to establish system for patients to report to commission serious adverse events occurring in hospitals.
- SB 236
Makes participation in Oregon Patient Safety Reporting Program mandatory for hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers.
